- It is my pleasure to join you today for the opening of this exhibition marking the 60th anniversary of the United Nations Institute for Training and Research (UNITAR). I would like to warmly congratulate UNITAR staff and its Executive Director Mr. Nikhil Seth on this milestone anniversary.
- UNITAR was created in 1963 to respond to a specific need of that time: following the Year of Africa, UNITAR provided hundreds of trainings and upskill for diplomats from newly independent states that joined the United Nations in the beginning of the 60s.
- The scope of UNITAR's activities has remarkably widened over the years, to become a world-renowned research center on multilateral diplomacy; economic development and social inclusion; environmental sustainability; sustainable peace; research and technology applications, to name just a few domains.
